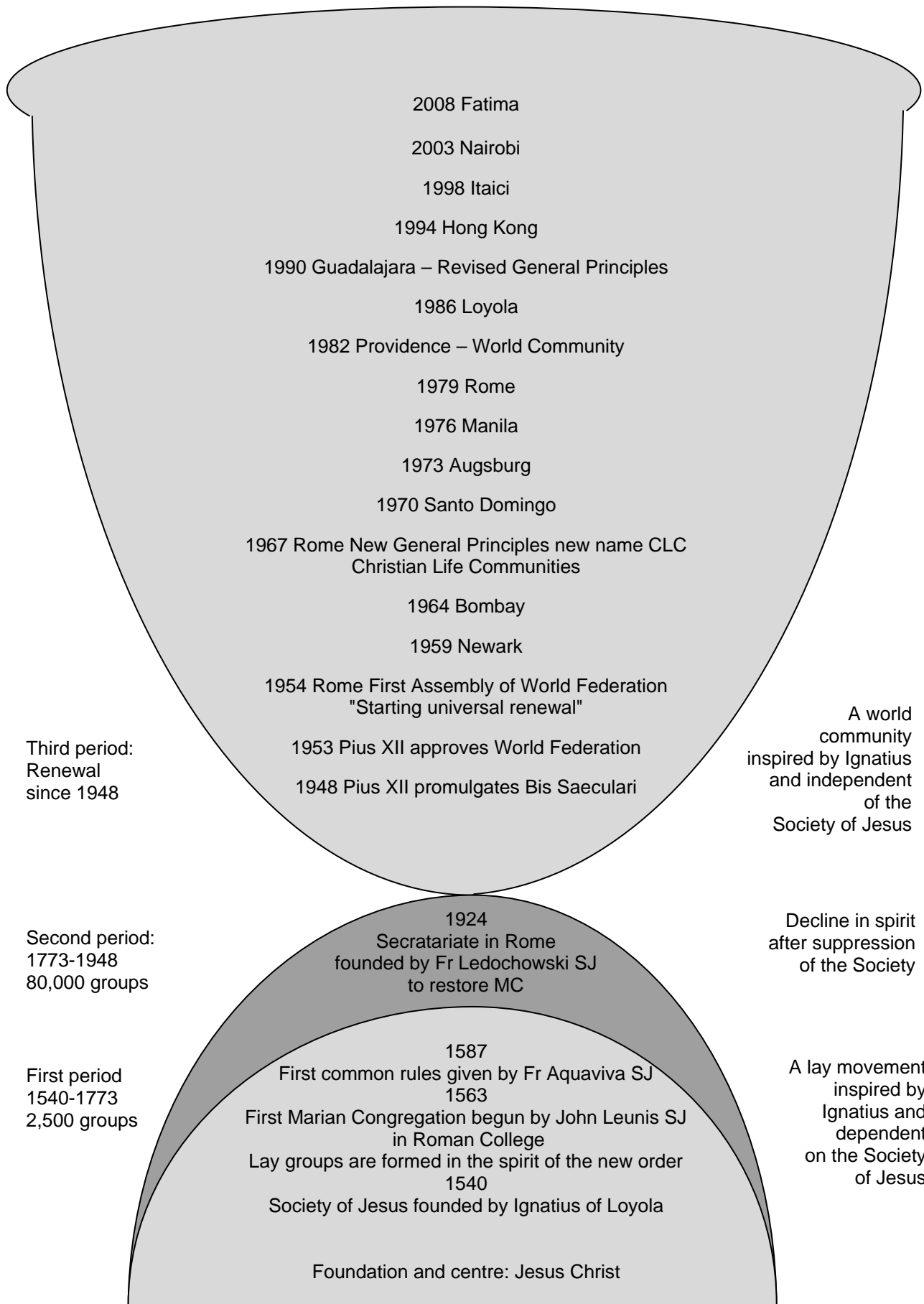


# CLC History: A participation in the paschal mystery
